*Ephesians 1:18-21 says: "I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people, and his incomparably great power for us who believe."

-How does what you know about God's "great power" from Scripture impact your faith?

*Paul prays that we might know God's "incomparably great power for us who believe." What role do you believe our belief plays in paving the way for God's great power to be experienced in our lives?

*2 Kings 2 tells the story of Elisha's request of a double portion of Elijah's spirit. What do you think is meant by the phrase, "Elijah's spirit."

*What does Elisha's request tell you about Elisha?

*Who is someone you consider to be a person of great faith and how does their perspective impact others?

*Which do you think God is more pleased by: bold prayers or cautious prayers and why do you think this is the case? Do your prayers tend to be more on the side of boldness or cautiousness?

*What challenges do you feel or face that sometimes limit your level of faith?

*What is one thing you feel like God may be saying to you through this message?
