*Hebrews 11:1 tells us that *"Faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see."* Has there ever been in a time in your life that you had a strong confidence that something was going to happen even though it had yet to be seen or happen? If so, share about that experience.

*Hebrews 11:6 says, *"Without faith it is impossible to please God..."* Why do you think faith is so pleasing to God and why might a lack of faith be displeasing to Him?

*Take a moment to review John 14:12-14: Very truly I tell you, whoever believes in me will do the works I have been doing, and they will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father. And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. You may ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it.
