SOMETHING TO THINK ABOUT FROM THE MESSAGE (5-10-20)

*John 19:28 says that *“Knowing that everything had now been finished, and so that Scripture would be fulfilled, Jesus said, “I am thirsty.”* Fulfilling Scripture or prophecies was one of the avenues God used to people toward Jesus as the Son of God. If you believe that Jesus is God, why do you believe that Jesus is God?

*What might be some reasons people don't believe that Jesus is God?

*If Jesus is God, what difference does that make in your life?

*The words, *“I am thirsty”* also serve as a reminder of the humanity of Jesus. Why does the fact that Jesus became like one of us matter to you?

*The image of thirst can also be used to describe an intense desire. If a person truly has a thirst for God, what might their life look like?

*In John 6:35, Jesus declared, *“I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty.”* What do you think Jesus meant by these words?

*Jesus said, *“Let anyone who is thirsty come to me and drink.”* What are you most needing from God at this time? Take a moment to bring these needs to God in prayer.
