WHAT DO YOU SEE?

*When Jesus returned to His hometown, we read that: *“He could not do any miracles there, except lay his hands on a few sick people and heal them. He was amazed at their lack of faith.”* Mark 6:5-6 How do you reconcile the idea of Jesus being an all-powerful God in the flesh with what you read in this passage?

*In Numbers 13-14, we read about the decision that Moses and the Israelites faced as they considered the prospect of possessing the promised land. God began by instructing Moses to send some men to explore the land of Canaan. Before stepping out in faith, why might it be important to consider all the factors?

-How might considering all the factors sometimes work against the call to step out in faith?

-What might be some keys to balancing due diligence with paralysis by analysis?

*How did Caleb and Joshua’s perspective differ from the others who went on the search mission? Why do you think they had such different perspectives?

*In what ways do you resemble Caleb and Joshua and in what ways do you resemble the others who gave a report?

*In Numbers 14, God describes the Israelites as having “treated him with contempt.” “Contempt” is defined as *“the offense of being disobedient to or disrespectful.”* What about the Israelites attitude or lack of action might be seen as a form of “contempt” and how might this apply to us?

*Because of their lack of faith and lack of action, most of the Israelites missed out on the promised land. What is one thing you sense God may be saying to you through this message?
