SOMETHING TO THINK ABOUT FROM THE MESSAGE (4-19-20)

*Luke 23:35 tells us that while Jesus was being crucified that there were those who “stood by watching.” What would you say to those who go through life thinking they can be neutral when it comes to Jesus?

*The repentant thief owned his sins. What might keep a person from owning their sins and why is it so important that we confess our sins to God?

*The repentant thief said, “Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom.” What were the circumstances that caused you to turn to Jesus as your Savior?
